April 19 - 23, 2023



Our OMA AT experience is priced at \$3750 per person in a double room sharing and \$4275 for a single traveler and includes all transportation, lodging, and specific meals during your trip. Two single travelers are welcome to share a room. All reservations require a charitable donation of \$100 that will go to the OMA's Acquisition Trust. This trip is limited to 20 guests and your booking is requested by January 30th, 2022. Reservations will be processed on a first come, first served basis. A minimum of 12 guests is required to operate this trip.

No refund will be provided for cancellations within sixty days of the trip's start date. If the client has another patron to fill a spot a substitution will be allowed. After the trip has commenced, no refunds are available, even if client does not partake in all of the trip's activities or leaves the trip early.
